









## 3i University Network funds seven projects strengthening cross-border collaborations

Launched in 2020, the cross-border 3i University Network brings together the University of Lille (France), KU Leuven, Ghent University (Belgium) and the University of Kent (United Kingdom) to collaborate on addressing the regional challenges shared in the Flanders-Kent-Hauts-de-France territory, in cooperation with public authorities, socio-economic actors and civil society.

In order to enhance the collaborations between researchers, a call for collaborative projects was launched in the summer of 2023, aiming to support academic staff of the four partners who want to set up or increase their cross-border collaborations with the specific goal of submitting joint project applications for larger grants. The proposals should actively involve external partners (industry, private sector, civil society, public bodies, ...) and foster societal impact.

A total of seven projects were selected and funded for a total amount of €60,000, made available by the four partners of the network. The seven selected projects cover the 4 major themes on which the network is primarily collaborating on:

Marine and Maritime challenges: 1 project

Climate and Energy: 1 projectHealth and Nutrition: 2 projects

Well-being and communities: 4 projects

All funded projects, up to a maximum of €10,000€ per project, have the explicit goal of submitting proposals for external funding to advance the existing collaboration to a next phase. The proposed activities will be organised in the cross-border region (Hauts-de-France region, Flanders region or Kent County) between 1 January and 31 December 2024. The projects cover very diverse themes, such as migration and inclusion, sustainable seafood, arts and humanities, sustainable campus mobility, integration and wellbeing of refugees, alternative proteins for cancer biomarkers and age verification systems.
